- 3. Assist, develop and implement relevant professional development
- 4. Prepare necessary local and state reports as directed
- 5. Assist and work with schools and universities regarding internship programs and placements
- 6. Continue personal and professional growth and apply acquired skills
- 7. Provide leadership to help implement department and District improvement efforts
- 8. Maintain a referral, screening and diagnostic system to identify students in need of speech and language services
- 9. Fulfill the ISBE requirements for a speech-language case study evaluation
- 10. Counsel each student with respect to future educational and/or vocational potential
- 11. Offer consultative services to school personnel regarding students receiving therapy
- 12. Arrange meetings with parents or guardians for observation of therapy and/or informative conferences
- 13. Attend staffing on students where speech/language may be involved or when professional counsel may be sought
