- 4. Have the ability to effectively manage students with various academic and behavior needs.
- 5. Have the ability to informally and formally assess learning and/or behavioral needs of students.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Work under the direction of the building principal and assistant principal, and in coordination with District 186 Student Support Services.
- 2. Work collaboratively with all special education and general education staff.
- 3. Provide instruction as determined by the students' Individual Education Plans (IEPs).
- 4. Participate in the development of comprehensive IEPs for identified students including behavior intervention plans.
- 5. Provide consultation, technical assistance and training to teachers and families of students experiencing learning or behavior problems.
- 6. Take responsibility for implementation of IEPs for students on assigned case load.
- 7. Implement the district's adopted special education curriculum, and supplement said curriculum as necessary to students' needs in consultation with building administration and District 186 Student Support Services.
- 8. Implement progress monitoring and data collection as determined through IEP.
- 9. Provide information to families regarding student progress and strategies that can be used at home to support the students' progress and growth.
